EVENTS AND ELIGIBILITY

U19 Men's (MS) and women's (WS) singles, men's (MD) and women's (WD) doubles and mixed doubles (XD). According to BWF rules, players born year 2004 or later can be accepted.

The maximum numbers of competitors accepted in the tournament are

64 players in men's and women's singles

32 pairs in men's and women's doubles

48 pairs in mixed doubles

Tournament will be played on 4 or 5 Pro Court mats depending on the number of entries.

No qualifications will be played before the main draw. If there are more entries for an event than can be accepted, the players/pairs will qualify for the main draw according to the rule 6.1.5 of the BE Junior Circuit regulations.

In accordance with regulation § 9.2 and § 9.3 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 8 (eight) competitors in the first published version of the main draw. If the required number of competitors is not met in









the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking. BADMINTON EUROPE is not liable for any costs incurred by third persons (players, coaches, umpires, team managers etc.) because of an event not having enough competitors to count for the rankings.

DRAW

All events will be played in a knock-out system. The seeding and draw will be made by BEC.

ENTRIES

All entries must be made by using the BWF Online Entry System: https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/tournament/6E9CB160-6A95-4D5F-A5F5-B9FD772A5567

Entry closing date: Tuesday, September 27, 2022, 18:59 local time (=GMT +03:00) No late entries will be accepted.

Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. Please create BWF IDs for all the players you wish to enter, but do not have a BWF ID-number yet. In case you're facing difficulties creating the player IDs please contact the BWF office, so that the players concerned can get their BWF ID-number before the closing date of the tournament.

The entries shall be made in order of strength and in national ranking order in each event. Players' date of birth is also required.

Compliance with General Competition Regulations Clause 7.9

GCR 7.9: "In making or authorising entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

ENTRY FEES AND PAYMENTS

Entry fees for the tournament are (shuttles included):

EUR 40 per player in singles events.

EUR 25 per player in doubles events.

12.1 The Member that enters a player/pair into a BEC Junior Circuit tournament is responsible for paying the entry fees for that player/pair. The entry fees become due if a player is entered and has not been withdrawn when the entry deadline passes. It is recommended that the entry fees are paid by bank transfer. Alternatively, the entry fees can be paid in cash at tournament before the first match.









12.2 The entry fees will not be refunded in the case of a withdrawal. For all the withdrawn players the organisers can invoice the entry fee to the relevant Member.

ADVERTISING AND CLOTHING

The tournament will be conducted according to the BWF Statutes, Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations 12 to 16 on advertising and clothing (*Player name on the back of shirt is mandatory*) and BEC Junior Circuit Regulation 13: It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same color of the t-shirt and shorts/skirts. Violating these regulations regarding clothing will be penalized with an administrative fine of 50,00 €. In applying these regulations, the decision of the Referee shall be final.

Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity

Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.

Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.
